#### **Materials**

The following materials have proved suitable for the metering tanks, pumps and lines for BAYHIBIT® AM: glass, stainless steel (e.g. DIN W1.4571 = US AISI 316 TI), plastics such as polyethylene, polytetrafluoro ethylene (PTFE) and polyvinyl chloride (PVC). Seals should be made from PTFE or graphite.
